Building Permit Application Requirements

The following are required when submitting for a building permit:

- 1. Completed application form
- 2. Proof of Title:
 - Copy of Registered Deed
- 3. Site Plan:
 - Showing exact location of proposed new building/addition, septic system, well, site drainage details. Note: if building sewer and/or water is to be hooked up to Municipal system, supply information regarding size and elevation.
- 4. Two (2) sets of drawings showing:
 - Complete cross-section of each structure in two directions
 - Floor plan layout showing complete dimensions for each floor and basement or pier locations
 - Elevations of front, sides and read of structure
 - Complete structural details
- 5. Heat Loss and/or heat gain calculations:
 - If air conditioning installed and duct design and layout.
 - Details of how sub-section 9.32.3 of the Ontario Building Code "Mechanical Ventilation" is to be met.
- 6. Entrance permit:
 - From appropriate road department, if required
- 7. Septic System Permit (if required)
- 8. Conservation Authority
 - Clearing letter, where applicable from appropriate Authority
- 9. Ministry of the Environment:
 - Where applicable, farm buildings "Certificate of Compliance"

FOR BUILDINGS UNDER SECTION 2.3.2 OF THE ONTARIO BUILDING CODE

- 10. Notice of Review of drawings by Ontario Ministry of Labour (where applicable)
- 11. Copy of Letter of Authorization to Architect or Engineer to allow submission of site visit and final report to the Chief Building Official.
