

New for 2010! Voter Identification Requirements

Voters voting at a voting place must show ID prior to obtaining a ballot. The following two options are considered acceptable forms of ID.

Option #1
An original copy of a document listed in Column A, if the document shows the person's name, qualifying address and signature.
Column A
An Ontario driver's licence
An Ontario Health Card (photo card)
An Ontario motor vehicle permit (plate portion)
A cancelled personalized cheque
A mortgage, lease or rental agreement
An insurance policy
A loan or financial agreement with a financial institution
A document issued or certified by a court in Ontario
Any other document from the government of Canada, Ontario or a municipality in Ontario or from an agency of such a government
Any document from a Band Council in Ontario established under the Indian Act (Canada)

Option #2	
An original copy of a document listed in Column B that shows the person's name and signature and an original copy of a document listed in Column C that shows the person's name and qualifying address.

An insurance policy	A document showing campus residence issued by the office or officials responsible for student residence at a post-secondary institution
A document issued or certified by a court in Ontario	A utility bill for hydro, water, gas, telephone or cable TV or a bill from a public utilities commission
Any other document from the government of Canada, Ontario or a municipality in Ontario or from an agency of such a government	A cheque stub, T4 statement of pay receipt issued by an employer
Any document from a Band Council in Ontario established under the Indian Act (Canada).	A transcript or report card from a post-secondary school
