

# Who May Vote?

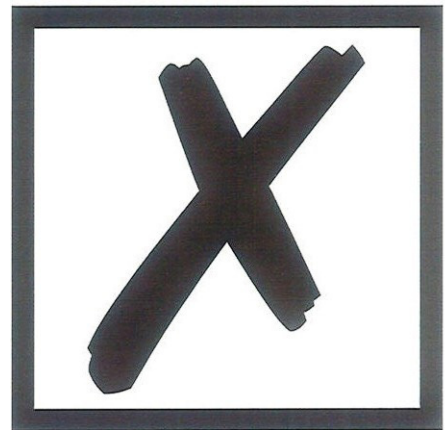
## Who May Vote? Who is Not Eligible to Vote?

Any person who on Voting Day meets the following qualifications is eligible to vote:

1. Is a Canadian Citizen;
2. Is at least 18 years of age on Voting Day;
3. Resides in the municipality or is the owner, tenant, or spouse, or same sex partner of the owner or tenant of land;
4. Any person not prohibited, by law, from voting.

The Municipal Elections Act, 1996, prohibits the following people from voting:

1. Any person who is not a qualified voter;
2. A person who is serving a sentence of imprisonment in a penal or correctional institution;
3. A corporation;
4. A person acting as an executor or trustee;
5. A person who has been convicted of corrupt practices under the Municipal Elections Act, 1996, in the last four years;
6. Anyone who is prohibited, by law, from voting.



## Where do I vote?

The Clerk, Meaghen Reid, will provide notice to the electors of Guelph/Eramosa to advise where they will vote.

Look for your Voter Notification card in the mail. This will set out the voting location for your poll.

Notice will also be published in the Wellington Advertiser and on the Township's website.

Each person only has one residence. An individual who moves prior to Voting Day is required to vote within the municipality at their new address.
