# Level Crossing Improvements

Road Closure: Main Street, Rockwood

Metrolinx is undertaking essential maintenance work along the rail corridor from Georgetown to Kitchener on GO Transit's Kitchener line. Weekend work to upgrade the Metrolinx rail crossing at Main Street in Rockwood will begin Friday, July 23, 2021.

### WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR YOU

Metrolinx and their contractor, **PNR RailWorks Inc.**, will undertake crossing upgrades and rail rehabilitation works, which will require the crossing to be closed to all traffic beginning **Friday**, **July 23** at 10 p.m. until **Sunday**, **July 25** at 6 p.m. There will be limited works on Monday, which will not impact pedestrian or vehicular traffic.

Impacts include changes to road and sidewalk access at the Main Street railway crossing during these times. During the closure, the Main Street railway crossing may not be functioning as expected and residents are advised to exercise caution and use alternate travel routes.

Residents may notice noise from machinery. The use of back-up beepers, a vital safety measure, will be limited to essential work only.
