## **PURPOSE OF APPLICATION:**

1. Relief from Section 4.4.1.2 of the Township's Zoning By-law 40/2016 to permit an additional residential unit (ARU) in an accessory building with a floor area equal to 81% of the floor area of the main dwelling up to a maximum area of 174m² whereas the maximum floor area of an ARU is not permitted to be more than an area equal to 45% of the floor area of the main dwelling up to a maximum area of 130m².

- 1. Whether the variance requested was minor;
- 2. Whether the variance requested was desirable for the appropriate development and use of the land;
- 3. Whether the general intent and purpose of the official plan will be maintained;

- 5. Whether this application has met the requirements of Section 45(2) of the <u>Planning Act</u> (in the case of a change in a use of property which is lawfully non-conforming under the by-law);

You are hereby notified that under Subsection 45(12) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, the applicant, the Minister or a specified person or public body that has an interest in the matter, may within **20 days** of the making of the decision, appeal to the Ontario Land Tribunal (OLT) against the decision of the Committee of Adjustment by filing with the Secretary-Treasurer of the Committee a Notice of Appeal setting out the objection to the decision and the reasons in support of the objection accompanied by payment to the Secretary-Treasurer of the fee charged by the OLT as payable on an appeal from a Committee of Adjustment to the OLT.

The Notice of Appeal may be filed either via the OLT's e-file service (first-time users will need to register for a My Ontario Account) at <a href="https://olt.gov.on.ca/e-file-service">https://olt.gov.on.ca/e-file-service</a> by selecting Township of Guelph/Eramosa as the Approval Authority, or by mail using the information provided with the undersigned below. Appeals must be filed no later than 4:30pm on **Tuesday, September 16<sup>th</sup>**, **2025**. The filing of an appeal after 4:30pm, in person or electronically, will be deemed to have been received the next business day. The appeal fee of \$1,100 can be paid online through e-file, or by certified cheque/money order to the Minister of Finance, Province of Ontario.
