## Election Campaign Signs – Requirements under the Municipal Elections Act, 1996

The purpose of this Bulletin is to advise on the Township of Guelph/Eramosa's interpretation and administration of the new provisions in the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* (the "MEA") that require identification information to be included on election campaign signs placed on public and private property.

The legislation and the 2018 Candidates' Guide indicate the following:

As outlined in the table above, the Candidates' Guide is not meant to replace provincial legislation and the MEA does not provide clear direction regarding identification requirements for candidate election campaign signs as it does for registered third party advertisers.



In accordance with Section 12 of the MEA, the Clerk for the Township of Guelph/Eramosa will interpret a candidate election campaign sign **that identifies the candidate** as meeting the requirements of subsection 88.3(2) of the MEA for the purposes of the municipality exercising any authority under Section 88.7 of the MEA.

Section 88.7 of the MEA states that, "If a municipality is satisfied that there has been a contravention of section 88.3, 88.4 or 88.5, the municipality may require a person who the municipality reasonably believes contravened the section or caused or permitted the contravention, or the owner or occupier of the land on which the contravention occurred, to remove the advertisement or discontinue the advertising.
