The Township of Guelph/Eramosa is located at the south end of Wellington County and is a vibrant rural and small urban municipality that includes the settlement areas of Rockwood, Eden Mills, Everton, Marden, Ariss and Cross Creek.

The Township has two contract vacancies for *Parks and Recreation Maintenance Technicians* beginning approximately April 13, 2026, and working through to and including November 27, 2026.

Reporting to the Parks and Recreation Lead Hand, this position is responsible for supporting the seasonal Parks Maintenance program. Duties include general maintenance, assisting with construction projects, maintaining parks and buildings, operating commercial mowers and landscape equipment, and providing support for special events as required.

The successful candidate will have:

- ✓ Possess previous experience in Parks and Recreation (landscaping setting)
