The Township of Guelph/Eramosa is a vibrant rural and small urban municipality located at the south end of Wellington County which includes the settlement areas of Rockwood, Eden Mills, Everton, Ariss, Marden and Cross Creek.

The Township is currently seeking two (2) Summer Students in Public Works.

Reporting to the Public Works Foreman, the primary duties of this position include: assisting in seasonal maintenance and construction projects, performing repairs, roadside flagging, operation of light equipment, loading and unloading of materials, moving of signs, fences, mailboxes and pothole repairs.

The successful candidates shall possess a valid, unrestricted Ontario Class G Driver's Licence. Previous experience in landscaping or general construction and flagging is an asset. Physical tasks and the operation of light equipment are a requirement for the position as well as the ability to work independently and in a team environment. First Aid and/or CPR training would be considered an asset. Applicants must be returning to full-time studies in the following school term.

Successful applicants must:

- be available to work uninterrupted from May 4th until September 7th
- Attend mandatory training May 4th, 5th and 6th
- have a reliable form of transportation as work locations are in a rural setting without access to public transit.

The wage range for this position is \$20.51 to \$24.13 per hour.
