JOB SUMMARY:

The Public Works Summer Staff is responsible to the Public Works Foreman or their designate for seasonal maintenance and construction projects, roadside flagging and providing labour assistance to the Roads Division.

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:

- a) Responsible for conducting general maintenance functions.
- b) Flagging, directing traffic.
- c) Set up and moving of signs.
- d) Repairing and installing traffic signs.
- e) Cutting grass on roadsides.
- f) Cold/Hot mix patching.
- g) Roadside debris collection.
- Perform other related tasks of responsibilities as may be assigned.
- i) Perform his/her duties in accordance with the Township's Safety Policy and Procedures as well as the Occupational Health and Safety Act, including all applicable regulations.
