Facility Maintenance Technician Permanent Full-time, 40hrs/week

The Township of Guelph/Eramosa is located at the south end of Wellington County, surrounding the City of Guelph and is a vibrant rural and small urban municipality. The Township is currently seeking applications for a full-time Facility Maintenance Technician within the Parks and Recreation Department. The Facility Maintenance Technician is the lead staff for all facility renovations and maintenance. This position provides general maintenance, repairs and renovations to all municipal facilities, equipment and park infrastructure within the department.

The successful candidate will demonstrate excellent communication skills and the ability to work independently and in a team environment. The capability to perform physical tasks in varying environmental conditions is a requirement for this position. Reporting to the Parks and Recreation Supervisor, the primary duties of this position include:

- Responsible and accountable for conducting general maintenance and the repair and renovation of all municipally owned facilities
- Take lead role on construction and renovation projects
- Assist with setup, takedown and the operation of special events
- Responsible for completing regular safety and risk management checks associated with various Township owned lands and facilities
- Operate commercial vehicles and small power tools
- Assist with winter snow operations

The Township is seeking a successful candidate to possess:

- Post-Secondary Education related to facility management, skilled trade and/or project management
- Red Seal Endorsement in HVAC, Plumbing, Electrical or similar trade considered an asset
- Minimum 5 years' experience in facility maintenance, trade or general construction
- Skill set to take lead role in facility renovations and maintenance
- A valid Minimum Class G Ontario Driver's License in good standing to the satisfaction of the Township; Class D-Z License an asset
- Knowledge of facility operations including facility automation, electrical, plumbing, security, building maintenance and risk management gained through experience in property/building maintenance
- General construction skills such as electrical, plumbing, framing, masonry, and dry walling experience required

Successful applicant will be required to be placed on an afterhours "on-call" schedule.
