3. Establishing effective communication channels with local businesses.




4.Introducing the County's Economic Development Division as a resource to support your business, projects, and future growth.



5. Understanding goals and interests related to downtown revitalization efforts.










What is the boundary of Downtown Rockwood?

Business Expansion and Growth


- Business scale up

Training and network building

- Improvement of community infrastructure (i.e. roads and parking to manage event-related and conservation area traffic)


Navigating Government Resources

- Support for highway and community signage from the Ministry of Transportation (MTO)




What are the Busiest Days of the Week in Rockwood?

- Community Engagement


