ASSUMPTION OF RISK DURING COVID-19:

- You are not feeling well or are exhibiting flu-like symptoms, or any known COVID-19 symptoms (incl. fever, cough, difficulty breathing, etc.)
- You have been in contact with someone with COVID-19 and/or flu-like symptoms in the past 14 days.
- You have traveled outside of Canada in the past 14 days.
- You are considered vulnerable or at risk (elderly individuals, immune compromised or individuals suffering from serious health problems).

Tennis Court Rules During COVID-19 in alignment with Ontario Tennis Association Protocols:

- Practice Physical distancing; staying 2 meters away from others. Refrain from handshakes, high-fives and fist bumps.
- Double tennis permitted, following safe distance protocols
- Only players actively engaged in play are to be inside the fenced enclosure. Please wait outside the fenced area for your turn or in your vehicle.
- If the courts are busy leave and return at another time.
- If others are waiting for a court, playing time is limited to one hour.
- Avoid changing ends or courts.
- Bring your own uniquely marked balls, only pick up balls that you brought for play.
- Return balls to adjacent players using your foot or racquet not your hand.
- Bring your own hand sanitizer and use it before, during and after tennis court usage.
- Bring your own water and do not share.
- Bathrooms and water fountains in Rockmosa Park are closed. Plan your visit accordingly.
- Refrain from touching your face (wiping sweat) and common elements on the tennis courts.
- Failure to comply with these rules, social distancing requirements or improper use of the courts may result in the closure of the tennis courts.

The Rockwood Tennis Club is not operating during COVID-19. During this time courts are first come, first serve with free public access.
