The Township of Guelph/Eramosa is a vibrant rural and small urban municipality located at the south end of Wellington County which includes the settlement areas of Rockwood, Eden Mills, Everton, Ariss, Marden and Cross Creek.

The Township is currently accepting applications for Volunteer Firefighters for the Rockwood Fire Station. Successful applicants are required to:

- Demonstrate team work, ethical decision making, professionalism and interpersonal skills.
- Exhibit dedication towards making a difference in the Guelph/Eramosa community.
- Attend regular weekly training sessions, some weekend training will be required.
- Obtain the skills to control fires and assist in emergencies safely.
- Possess a valid DZ Driver's License or be able to acquire a DZ Driver's License within 6 months of hiring.
- Provide a recent driver abstract (within 30 days) in good standing and to the satisfaction of the Township of Guelph/Eramosa.
- Respond to emergencies with no prior notice.
- Fulfill the physical requirements of the position including heavy lifting and the ability to work under strenuous conditions.

Applicants must be 18 years of age or older at the time of application and live within the "primary response area". **If you do not live within the primary response area, your application will be rejected.**
